

There, he painted his most remarkable seascapes.§ Homerâ ™s oil painting, The Fox Hunt was his largest painting and the first to be bought by a major museum (Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts).NOTABLE WORKS:Breezing up, The Fox Hunt, Right and Left, Home Sweet Home, Snap the Whip, After the Hurricane.
