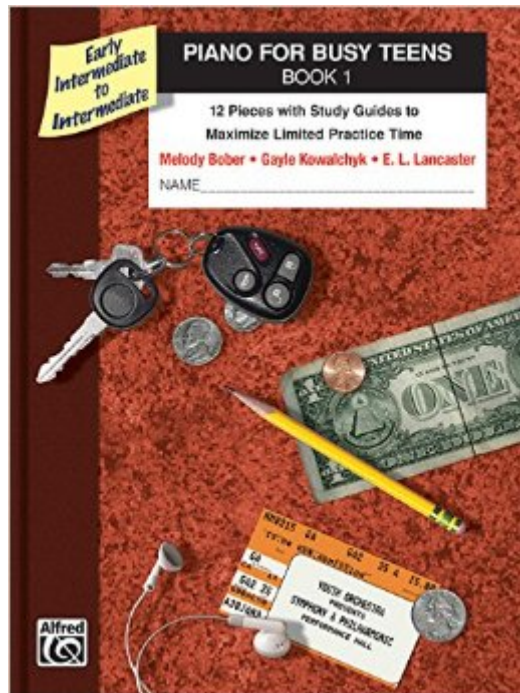

For Whom?: "Early Intermediate - Intermediate for students with limited practice time who need something to 'grab' them; presenting a variety of accessible classical music and modern tunes" Strengths: cool forward describing purpose of book; before every piece interesting anecdotes offered about piece; very well laid out; practice plan which divides piece into manageable well-labeled/designated sections and a time-table to work on them by Week; recommendations for polishing piece when learned; practical advice by week, takes into account limited practice schedules, and gives advice on how to optimize limited time; has a noble goal of student enjoying

music, but practicing effectively what they love; outlines well the points teachers would likely scrawl on the page in bad handwriting or in students' notebooks in a neat, modern, cool, accessible place; modern and fun and probably very accessible to a teen, or young adult; like a study guide with cliff's notes; rather than expecting students to memorize everything we say, we can learn from this format and present similar outlines for each piece which the student can continually refer to; some popular titles will grab the students' attention even if arrangedWeaknesses:unfortunately, arranges some Joplin badly, and a Beethoven piece mediocre-lyPedagogical Value:warm-up passagework usually highlighting measures w' difficult fingerings to drill a few times; various specific recommendations; a Hanon exercise in each book, with rhythmic variation, dynamic hairpins, and transposition to make it less drab / mindless; theoretical terms and historical background presented over timeHighlights:"Fast Track Boogie - Bobercouple authentic familiar tunes: Musette from Magdalena Notebook, Arabesque by BurgmullerFiesta Cha-Cha (duet) by Bober - Yesyes- very well done, a pleasure, title says it all!"
