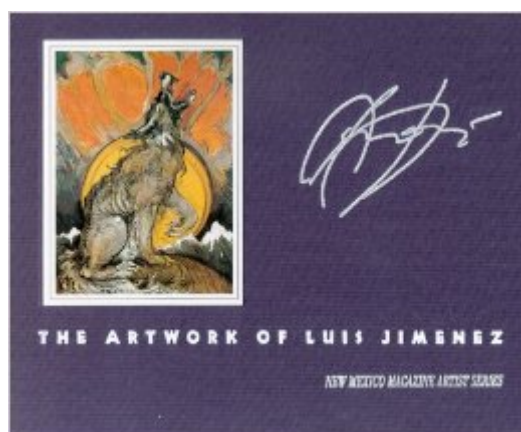


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Howl: The Artwork Of Luis JimÃ©nez (New Mexico Magazine Artist Series)



Synopsis

Artist Luis Jim  nez's distinctive portrayals of the reality of life in the Southwest have catapulted him to the forefront of the competitive art world and provide a healthy dose of social commentary. Perhaps the most visible of Jim  nez's work comes in the form of public sculptures that have been commissioned in many U.S. cities, including Pittsburgh, Denver, Albuquerque, Houston, New York, San Diego, and Buffalo, to name but a handful.
