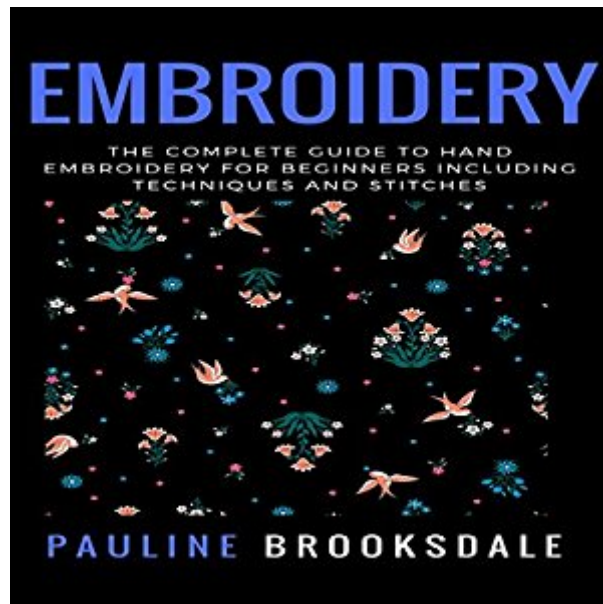

This book it's supposed to be about embroidery. However, most of it is knitting and crochet, even the projects. It also lacks pictures of stitches. Teaches very little on actual embroidery. Terrible book.

I wasn't expecting knit (knit and purl) and crochet terms in an embroidery book. It would have been more useful if a picture was included next to the descriptions of each of the stitches in the first part of the book. At least there were pictures of the projects in the second half of the book.
