

(Thank you Goodreads.com/First Reads for an early reader copy!) I have been a Sara Donati fan for years, her new book, The Gilded Hour, is her best yet. As usual, her books are populated by strong

characters, both male and female, and don't hesitate to take on inequities of the time period. Her characters are fully fleshed, and you feel like you know them, yet they are still consistent with the time period of the story. Anna Savard is a fully qualified teaching physician on staff at the New Amsterdam Charity Hospital, where, as a surgeon, she sees the poorest and most desperate patients. Sophie Savard is a free woman of mixed race from New Orleans, cousin to Anna, and also a fully qualified physician who specializes in obstetrics and pediatrics. Both in their twenties, they live with Aunt Quinlan and her adult stepdaughter Margaret. They practice in a time where vaccination is still something new and scary, where birth control can send you to jail, and where woman are discriminated and abused in a variety of completely legal ways. Rounding out the cast is Cap Verhoeven, an attorney and childhood playmate of Sophie and Anna's, who suffers from TB, and comes from a family of great wealth. All three of them, Anna, Sophie and Cap, are intelligent, well educated individuals who are aware of injustice and ignorance and do their best to fight it whenever possible. The story starts with Anna going to the docks to vaccinate a large group of Italian orphans. There she meets jack Mezzanotte, a police detective, who is translating for the orphans. There is chemistry between the two of them immediately, but Anna doesn't seem to know just what kind of chemistry it is. While on the docks, Anna meets a small group of children, Rosa, Lia, Tonino and Vittorio Russo.
